SUBJECT: Approval of Squadron Hat


1. CAPR 39-1 provides that unit commanders may authorize the wear of a unit Baseball Cap for wear with the ABU, when approved by the Wing Commander.
2. These caps will be conservative in color and will not be worn outside of unit activities. Red Baseball Caps may not be authorized, as this color is reserved by the Air Force for specific special duty units.
3. The MI-655 squadron hat consists of a black Condor Tactical Baseball Cap with an embroidered rectangular patch containing a simplified version of the squadron logo. (See Attachment 1)
4. The MI-655 squadron hat may be worn as follows:
  - a. With the ABU uniform at MI-655 meetings, events, or activities. The hat will not be worn with the ABU uniform at meetings, events, or activities held outside of the unit, when disallowed by an activity director, or when standard headwear is specified. A member may choose to wear standard headgear and will not be required to wear a squadron hat with this uniform.
  - b. With the corporate aviator shirt uniform, corporate field uniform, corporate flight duty uniform, or corporate working uniform at all CAP meetings, events, or activities except when disallowed by an activity director, or when standard headwear is specified. A member may choose to wear standard headgear and will not be required to wear a squadron hat with these uniforms.
  - c. With civilian attire. The squadron hat may be worn with civilian attire as long as doing so reflects positively on the member and on CAP. The squadron hat may not be worn to political rallies or at other times specified in CAPR 39-1, paragraph 1.2.8, where wearing CAP-related uniform items would be inappropriate or would bring discredit on CAP.
5. MI-655 Requests approval of the Michigan Wing Commander for permission for members of MI-655 to wear the unit baseball cap in accordance with CAPR 39-1, as described above. 1<sup>st</sup> Lt
